SCHOLARSHIPS

International students can apply for scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 after arriving on campus. When it's time to transfer to a 4-year university, some schools offer a special scholarship based on GPA when transferring from SPSCC.



WORK EXPERIENCE

International students are eligible to apply to work at the College. Students gain professional and leadership experience outside of the classroom through internships and Optional Practical Training (OPT), and earn extra money.



HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION PATHWAY

SPSCC offers international students the chance to earn both a high school diploma in Washington State and an associate degree at the same time through the International High School Completion Program.

Program Advantages

- Earn a Washington State high school diploma and an associate degree at the same time.
- Graduate from college at an earlier age by completing an associate degree during high school age years.





Transfer & University Pathway Program

SPSCC Transfer Program allows students to complete their first two years of college at SPSCC and then transfer to a university to complete two more years and earn a bachelor's degree.

By completing the first two years of college at SPSCC, students can:

- ◆ Save \$25,000 USD \$40,000 USD per year
 - Earn an associate degree
- Gain experience in college-level coursework, making the transition to a 4-year university easier




