My name is Kayla Johnson. With my colleague, Lyndsey Larkin, we are your Kings Progression Advisors at UW Oshkosh, Fox Cities campus and Fond du Lac campus.

The role of the team is to ensure you are happy, secure and fully prepared for your degree at UW Oshkosh, Fox Cities and Fond du Lac.

We call it the Kings **GO: Supported** service. We're here to help you make the most of your time at UWO, to develop your academic profile and most importantly, to help you make the next step by transferring to graduate from your dream university.

With around 2,000 students, Fox Cities and Fond du Lac are medium-sized campuses, which can be a little overwhelming without support. As a Kings student you have the best of both worlds. You'll enjoy full participation and access to all the resources of this beautiful campus. But you'll also have all the personal support and advice you need during your time here.



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Here's what we commit to you as part of the Kings GO: Supported service:

1. Pre-departure Support

We will:

- Connect with you online even before you travel to the US, we'll set up online sessions to prepare you for your departure

2. Campus Life Support

We will:

- provide a guided tour of the UWO campus
- support you in setting up bank accounts, a local mobile number and can offer local city tours
- help you navigate your life at UWO, for example if you have any housing questions or concerns
- help you connect with campus resources
- help in creating and implementing fun social events and excursions so that you can enjoy your time at UWO (eg, Six Flags, NBA/MLB/NFL games, Chicago, Milwaukee, Wisconsin Dells, etc.)
- help you navigate your healthcare needs, for example setting you up with a doctor or dentist
- be available to you through your preferred communication channel: WeChat, LINE, KakaoTalk, WhatsApp, iMessage

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3. Academic and Career Support

We will:

- set up a personalized study plan for you, so that you can earn as many credits as possible and transfer to your dream university
- help you register for classes
- support you in selecting your major
- identify and provide additional support to academically at-risk students
- issue progress reports four times a year
- provide various online and offline resources so you can prepare for standardized tests such as the TOEFL, SAT and ACT (These are unnecessary for some universities, but may be required for other elite universities)
- help you find a subject tutor, if you need extra academic support (Additional fees may apply)
- support you with writing assignments
- assist you to join "Study Table" once a week and meet with your advisor, if your GPA drops under 3.2
- work with you to draft and perfect your resume and cover letters
- help you find volunteer opportunities or activities that are associated with your field of studies
- offer a career aptitude test to decide on your career field

4. Top 100 Transfer Support

We will:

- guide you through your transfer to a top 100 university, or a university of your choice
- assess your previous academic history and will help you in collecting necessary documents
- meet with you at least twice a month and a minimum of 20 hours per year. (You are welcome to meet us as often as possible)
- help research universities appropriate for your major and research admissions requirements for target universities
- arrange and guide target university tours, as well as select university tours in and around Wisconsin, such as UW Oshkosh, UW-Madison, UW-Milwaukee, Marquette University, University of Chicago, and Northwestern University with free lunch and transportation. You will meet with professors or admissions staff at each university. (All university tours are subject to availability)
- help you gather recommendations. For example help draft emails to professors, determine which professors/person would be best and coach you on communication skills
- set up a mock interview to improve your admission interview techniques
- help you boost your student profile (academic/extracurricular)
- host regular workshops and seminars such as the overview of U.S. Education System, the Common Application, standardized testing, transfer application and essays, etc
- help you accept a transfer offer and complete transfer paperwork
- guide you through the university application process as well as help with personal statement development and essay writing
- help you communicate with the admissions department of your target universities
- support you researching for potential scholarship opportunities
