Dear Kings Education Student,

Congratulations on your admission into a Kings Premier Universities program at College of Mount Saint Vincent! We're pleased that you have expressed an interest in continuing your studies at the University of Rochester. Under our partnership with Kings Education it is our honor to offer you conditional admission.

To be admitted as a transfer student under our Kings Education agreement, you must:

1. Submit a formal transfer application including the Common or Coalition Application, recommendation, all official transcripts, and a copy of this Conditional Admission letter. The application deadline is March 15 for the fall semester and October 1 for the spring semester.
2. Arrange to have a course-by-course transcript evaluation with your application materials if you have college credits from a non-US university.
3. Be on track to complete at least three academic semesters (1 1/2 years) in a Kings program, accumulating at least 40 transferable credit hours, earning a minimum 3.5 cumulative grade point average across all college-level credits.
4. Demonstrate English proficiency if you are an international student by:
 - o Successfully completing a college-level English writing course, earning a B or better.
 - o Submitting official TOEFL iBT or revised paper exam score of 100 (individual band scores no lower than 24) or an IELTS exam with an overall score of 7.5 (individual scores no lower than 7.5), and
 - o Complete an admissions interview (off campus, on campus, or virtual) when applying, demonstrating effective conversational communication.
5. Demonstrate your ability to meet the full cost of attendance if you are an international student by completing an International Financial Support Form. Students unable to meet the full cost of attendance may apply for need-based aid by submitting the CSS PROFILE. Due to limited resources, only a select number of international applicants will qualify for need-based financial aid. Applicants who are unable to secure the needed funding to cover the cost of attendance through private funds or need-based aid cannot be admitted to the University.


Once your application for admission has been received and reviewed, you will receive a formal admissions letter welcoming you as a transfer student if you have met the conditional requirements.
