


SmartClass

Course Structure

22.5 hours

- 7.5 hours of live English instruction (2 x 45 minutes per day)

- 5 hours of structured self-study

Course Content / Curriculum

Essential English SmartClass improves reading, writing, speaking and listening at a consistent rate. Each week, lessons will focus on a different topic.

Students preparing for IELTS or TOEFL will be fully prepared to maximise their test scores.



Notes on bookings

- Students must book with at least 48 hours' notice prior to course start date (excluding weekends)
- Students will first need to take the online Kings level test to be placed into the correct class. This must be taken under exam conditions without dictionary/internet assistance. Please submit this with your booking for the most efficient response.

- Students will receive details of their class times/level and the log in details to join their **SmartClass** course 24 hours before the start of their course.
