



SCHOLARSHIPS

International Student Tuition Waiver

No need to apply! All students with a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) are considered automatically for this scholarship. The scholarship is \$1,750 for the first semester at LCSC and is renewed each semester.

Eligibility Requirements:

- · Maintain a 2.5 semester grade point average
- · Complete 12+ credits each semester
- ·Volunteer 10+ hours per semester
- · Are not fully funded by a sponsoring agency

After the first semester of enrollment at LCSC, the scholarship amount can increase:

- \cdot 2.5 GPA = \$1,750 per semester or \$3,500 per year
- \cdot 3.0 GPA = \$2,125 per semester or \$4,250 per year
- \cdot 3.5 GPA = \$2,500 per semester or \$5,000 per year

At the Institute of Intensive English (IIE), we offer a selection of programs that are designed with you in mind. Whether you want to study short-term and immerse yourself in the local culture, or challenge yourself with pre-university studies preparation, we have the right program for you.

LCSC offers a comprehensive and intensive English-language program to students who are high beginner through advanced levels. Students attend 18-24 hours of English-language classes each week. The IIE offers a variety of electives each semester which may include Pronunciation, IELTS/TOEFL Preparation, American Culture, American Board Games, and America through Music.

Bridge Program

Students are granted admission to college without taking the IELTS/TOEFL by passing our rigorous and demanding Bridge program. After completion, graduates will be prepared for studying in the U.S.A. Students attend 18 hours of English-language courses each week, in addition to a 3-credit college class.

Summer Programs

The IIE offers a summer semester and a shorter 5-week program that begins in July.

Customized Programs

LCSC offers customized programs for groups upon request. Programs include English for specific purposes such as business English training. We usually can provide a full-service program for a lower price than many of our competitors.

Being in a foreign country can be a challenging experience! The International Programs Office has a homestay program that gives international students


a safe, comfortable home while they study at LCSC. In return, the students' host families will have the chance to learn more about another culture as well as share their American culture. \$570/month
